Laura Williams asked for a motion to approve the February General Meeting Notes that were posted to both Facebook and our website. Mindy Hill motioned to approve and Lisa Hartmann 2nd the motion. February 2019 meeting notes approved.

Tracy Campbell has contracted CT Promo and Imaging to host our next and final spirit wear sale of the school year. This online store and link are live and will be presented to membership as of Monday, March 11th, 2019. It will be available on the Booster website, Facebook page and Ms. Lanute will post to her teacher page. Tracy Campbell will also email the link to both middle school Directors so that it may be shared with incoming freshman families. We need to close the store in enough time to get delivery of items prior to the end of the school year. The closing date will be posted and is TBD.

Our largest fundraising event of the year is happening this weekend, March 9th, 2019 at the Wesmere Country Club. We are hosting a pancake dinner and we have sold out the first seating at 5pm. We have about ½ capacity left for the 6:30pm seating. There will be both a silent auction and a split the pot raffle available. The raffle tickets will be \$1 each and the silent auction tickets will be \$2 each. No dinner tickets will be printed, the party that purchased the tickets should simply give their name at the door to be marked off of the master list. If you signed up for the 5pm seating, your name will be on that list, if you signed up for 6:30pm seating, your name will be on that list.

Mindy Hill has signed up to make pancakes ahead of time for us and will need the mix and foil pan delivered to her. Lisa Hartmann and Laura Williams will take care of that delivery.

Director's Notes;
